## **IBA Names Two Scholarship Recipients**

The Indiana Bankers Association (IBA) has named **Deon Shoaf, First Bank of Berne**, and **Bryan Stahl, The Peoples Bank, Brownstown**, recipients of the Prochnow Educational Foundation/ IBA Scholarship. Shoaf serves First Bank of Berne as assistant vice president; Stahl is vice president & manager, information systems, at The Peoples Bank.

Each scholarship recipient will receive a \$1,250 discount from the regularly charged fees for each of the three years of the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. This \$3,750 scholarship, established and funded by the Herbert V. Prochnow Educational Foundation, furthers the goal of supporting banker education. The scholarship is made available annually to select individuals who demonstrate outstanding leadership and commitment to community and the banking industry.

“The banking industry and the communities we serve have a bright future because of the leadership of bankers such as Deon Shoaf and Bryan Stahl,” said Laurie Rees, IBA vice president-education & training. “This scholarship is in recognition of their leadership within their banks and the communities they serve,” Rees continued.
